**RE: Notre Dame College School Circular No. 10 (2017-2018)**

This is to inform all parents about all school events, holidays and special arrangements taking place in June.

1. Suspension of Extra-curricular Activities: Examination Week (Form 1 to Form 5) of the second term will be held from 5 June (Tuesday) to 21 June (Thursday). All extra-curricular activities will be suspended starting from 28 May (Monday). Your children are expected to make good use of their time for revision.
2. Dragon Boat Festival: 18 June (Monday) is the Dragon Boat Festival.
3. Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA): TSA - Chinese, English and Mathematics subjects for Form 3 students will take place in the morning on 19 June (Tuesday) and 20 June (Wednesday). Students should attend school as normal before 8:15am, and they will be dismissed by 12:30 noon. There will be no school in the afternoon.
4. Post-exam Special Arrangement: Form 1 to Form 5 students should attend school as normal before 8:15am on 22 June (Friday) and 25 June (Monday). They will be dismissed by 3:20pm. Form 1 to Form 3 students must stay at school during lunch time. Please pay special attention to the schedule of your child. For more details as to the post-exam activities and summer extra lessons (Form 4 and Form 5), please refer to the Special School Circular.
5. Church and Museum Visit: The Religious Education Department will organise an extended learning lesson for Form 5A students from 1:35pm to 3:40pm on 22 June (Friday). They will visit the Rosary Church and the exhibition "An Age of Luxury: the Assyrians to Alexander" launched by Hong Kong Museum of History, accompanied by Religion teacher and class teacher throughout the activity. Students will get on the tour bus at the school and go to the venue. They will be dismissed once the activity finishes. For more details, please refer to the Special School Circular.
6. Post-exam Activities: Post-exam activities will take place from 26 June (Tuesday) to 17 July (Tuesday). For more details, please refer to the Special School Circular.

7. Jubilee School Anniversary Celebration: Jubilee School Anniversary Celebration will be held at the Academic Community Hall of Hong Kong Baptist University at 3pm on 7 July (Saturday). Students must wear neat school uniform and meet outside the Academic Community Hall on time at 2:30pm. Students should enter the hall according to the instruction given by the teachers and enjoy the performance. The activity will finish at 5:30 pm. We would like to invite parents and guardians of our Form 1 to Form 5 students to join this activity, and tickets will be distributed. Due to limited seats, each student can only receive two tickets for parents and guardians, whereas other relatives and children are not invited. The tickets will be distributed to your child later. Please be reminded that you will have to bring along the tickets and arrive at the venue before 2:45pm. For more details, please refer to the Special School Circular.
